Here's how you can become a Baltimore Watercolor Society Signature Artist Member

To begin the evaluation process for
BWS Signature Artist membership,
complete and mail the application form.
You will be notified by mail of the date, time, and place of
evaluation by the Board of Governors.
(Associate members may join at any time.)

*
When you receive the notification packet,
select four (4) framed examples of your recent work.
Works should be of professional quality, original in
concept and execution, and not copied or derived from a
student class or workshop.

*
On the day of jurying, place tape on the glass over your
signature and deliver your work to the designated
location *at the time indicated* in the notification packet.
Return to that location *at the time indicated* and pick up
your work. You will be notified of the Board's decision
within 10 days.

*
If your work is favorably reviewed for signature level
membership, you will become an
Artist Member
upon receipt of your \$30 annual dues.

*
If you live more than a 45-minute drive from Baltimore,
you may instead submit by mail four (4) slides of your
recent work by the designated deadline, to be evaluated
the same day as the paintings.
