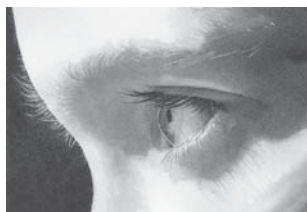
BRENDA KIDERA has been a professional artist since 1983 and instructor since 1997. She has been working in watercolor for 35 years. An Artist member of BWS since 1987, she is also a juried member of the Potomac Valley Watercolorists and the Washington Society of Landscape Painters. Her work has been featured in *Watercolor Magic* and has won numerous awards. She has exhibited widely and served as a juror in several exhibitions.

THE WORKSHOP will concentrate on how to paint watercolor portraits using a controlled, layering method that takes the fear out of painting portraits. With so much to cover in two days, all reference material will be provided. You can transfer from these with graphite paper or draw from them. This course focuses on paint application and how to model the forms. With step-by-step demonstrations and one-on-one interaction, we will begin with monochromatic

studies of individual features and progress to a full color portrait.

#12 or #14 Round
#6 or #8 Round

PAPER Arches 140# cold press 10x14" watercolor block

PAINT I use Winsor & Newton ARTIST'S *Monochromatic Studies*: neutral tint preferred; can use other dark colors.

Color Studies:

yellow ochre *sepia or burnt umber*
brown madder *French ultramarine blue*
alizarin crimson *hooker's green dark:*
cadmium red (Grumbacher Artist's Grade)

Bring your other colors too!

masking fluid and rubber cement pick-up block
graphite paper (I'll have for purchase at workshop)
red or purple or blue ballpoint pen
12" ruler
tape
kneaded eraser, palette
